Footnotes

MY D'ORO steadied along the inside on the first turn, stalked the pace, angled to the rail leaving the far turn and slipped through inside LASTER to gain a slim lead approaching the eighth pole, then was all out to prevail. LASTER vied for the lead outside ECLIPTICALSWILDCAT, responded when challenged by GRAD STUDENT midway of the far turn, was contesting the pace with that one when MY D'ORO gained the advantage and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire. GRAD STUDENT rated off the pace, rallied three wide to reach even terms for command midway of the far turn, vied with LASTER to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. COOKING UP A STORM reserved in striking position after breaking awkwardly, tired in the drive. CATDUEL was through after a half mile. ECLIPTICALSWILDCAT stumbled at the start, vied for the lead along the inside into the far turn and faltered. HAYATI SON chased the pace three wide to the far turn, then faded.
