DON'TCALLMECHARLEY unhurried early, rallied along the inside to be up late. FOREVER NOBLE rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and rallied for the place while being outfinished by the winner. ONE PROUD GIRL allowed to settle, raced three wide around the turn and finished willingly along the outside to be just up for the show. DREAMING OF BELLA chased the pace three wide, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and opened a clear lead, then gave way late. EDISTO LADY reserved racing along the rail, failed to menace. NEGRITA TATA outrun early, raced four wide and never threatened. ELLERSLIE PARK showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then tired. SYDNEY RULES chased the pace along the rail around the turn and faltered.
