The latter, chased the pace along the inside, eased outside the winner for the drive and was gaining slowly at the finish. SUGAR N SPICE unhurried early, saved ground and closed to gain the show. DREAM WISH showed some early foot and tired. PAGEANT BABY bobbled at the start, chased the pace off the rail into the stretch and gave way. TOUR HOSTESS raced three wide and faltered.
