**Footnotes**

FRANKLINPARK reserved early, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then was fully extended to hold off JIM N JOHN. The latter, outrun after breaking slowly, swung out for the stretch run and closed well for the place while unable to get to the winner. NO CALCETINES stalked the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command at the eighth pole but was outfinished. FINANCIAL PATHWAY rated off the pace, improved his position without threatening. REVERE'S RIDE off slowly, rushed up along the backstretch to join the leader, took over from C D GOLD on the far turn and opened a clear lead racing into the stretch, then tired in the final eighth. WAT allowed to settle, rushed up to join the leaders on the backstretch, chased those rivals three wide around the far turn and faltered. GREYRUNFORMV was not a factor. C D GOLD pressed the early pace outside MR. J G, took over from that rival on the backstretch and eased to the inside, made the pace to midway of the far turn, then dropped back. EL TUSCANO pressed the pace for more than a half mile, then was fading when steadied on the far turn. MR. J G showed brief speed along the rail and stopped.
