Footnotes

ALCANUDANCE set the pace under pressure racing off the rail, then drew off through the stretch while being kept to the task. TARZANITO reserved early, saved ground and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. SHOTGUN DUTY rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed to gain the show. SCORION was chasing the pace when checked from close quarters racing down the backstretch, angled out and advanced four wide to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then tired. SPARTAN GENERAL broke awkwardly, then was no factor while racing four wide. POKER TRICK pressed the winner three wide to nearing the stretch, then faltered. HOW TO KNOW showed early foot off the rail and faded.
