Footnotes

AZAFRAN bumped with HARRISON BAY at the start, pressed the pace outside MYSTIC STRIKE, gained command from that rival leaving the turn, then drew off. MYSTIC STRIKE set the pace under pressure along the inside to the quarter pole, then was no match for the winner while clearly best of the others. WHINING stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. EEK broke a step slowly, raced three wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. LUDICROUS SPEED off slowly, was never a factor. HARRISON BAY was outrun after being steadied when he bumped with AZAFRAN at the start. FAN BASE chased the pace into the turn and tired. EL GRANDE MONTE fractious in the gate, steadied on the backstretch and faltered. TRULY MEMORABLE chased the pace along the inside to past midway of the turn, then faded. JOEY'S NIGHT RIDER was through early.
