Footnotes

B L'S A RUNNER tracked the speed three wide around the turn, assumed command turning for home and drew off under a strong hand ride. HELLO MECKE reserved off the pace while saving ground, steadied entering the turn and nearing the quarter pole, angled out for racing room in mid stretch and was just up for the place while no match for the winner. EL QUIXOTE made the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch and gave way. WAIT IN LINE broke a step slow, in good position three wide around the turn and weakened in the drive. ALLSMARTS raced up close while off the rail and tired in the stretch run. ARTILLERY EXCHANGE was well placed and faded. ASTALA TRIEST BABY passed tiring rivals after breaking a step slowly. AFRIKAN SUN failed to menace. BAILEY'S DYNASTY was off a step slow and outrun.
