Footnotes

FLATTER THIS pressed the pace outside ONE NEAT CAT, took over from that rival inside the eighth pole and edged away. ONE NEAT CAT hit the gate at the start, set the pace under pressure along the rail to past the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the others. BIM BAM off slowly, saved ground around the turn and gained the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. BERNIE THE MAESTRO raced with the pace three wide to the top of the stretch and tired. CONCORDE'S FURY chased the leaders four wide around the turn, then faltered. PRINCE JACK saved ground and never threatened. DELAWARE RIDGE trailed.
