Footnotes

ENOUGH THUNDER unhurried while saving ground, advanced into contention around the far turn, angled outside the leaders, rallied to gain the lead at the eighth pole, then drew away. UNDISPUTED QUEEN was chasing the pace when steadied along the inside on the first turn, moved through to take over on the backstretch and opened a clear lead, responded when challenged on the far turn, was vying for the lead when she bumped repeatedly with CROWN GLORY in the stretch, then couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. CROWN GLORY stalked the pace, moved up on the far turn to vie for the lead outside UNDISPUTED QUEEN, then was bumping repeatedly with that rival when checked from inside ENOUGH THUNDER just past the eighth pole and gave way. NERVOUS NELL stalked the pace three wide, made a run to join the leaders on the far turn, then tired in the drive. POPPIN'S PRIDE moved up around the first turn to stalk the pace off the rail to nearing the stretch, then faltered. STOKES BRIDGE failed to menace. FOR B. AND W. raced three wide and faded. ABUELITA showed brief speed, stopped and was eased in the stretch run. The rider of CROWN GLORY lodged an objection against the rider of ENOUGH THUNDER for alleged interference in the stretch. The claim of foul was not allowed.
