I'M A PLAYBOY showed speed along the inside, responded when challenged by YES HE'S INNOCENT at the quarter pole, then dueled with and just edged that rival to the wire. YES HE'S INNOCENT chased the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command with I'M A PLAYBOY at the quarter pole, then dueled with that rival to the wire and just missed. ON APPEAL chased the pace four wide, made a run to reach the leaders at the quarter pole, then gave way. AND I LIKE IT TOO failed to menace. UPTONOW prompted the pace three wide into the turn and tired. ALISA'S ENGINEER was not a factor. BON APPETIT trailed after breaking poorly.
