ALOHA KANA sprinted to a clear lead off the rail, and drew off while being kept to task. HORNET raced wide down the back stretch, moved into the four path around the turn to reach the attending position then held the place while no match for the winner. MR. LIVINGSTON, off slowly, raced along the inside and improved his position. RARE GIN, reserved early, raced evenly. MEGACLES, bothered at the start, was taken up entering the turn and failed to recover. DUCKY LUCKY steadied when he swerved in after the start and passed tiring rivals. CARIBBEAN RIVER was well placed and weakened. FORTONITE steadied after hitting the gate, raced six wide around the turn and was no factor. WIRE LEADER swerved in at the start, raced in good position on the inside and tired. ADMIRAL PROSPECTOR pressed the pace inside of ALOHA KANA, was checked entering the turn and stopped.
