Footnotes

AIN'T LIFE GRAND set the pace racing off the rail, lost the lead to IT'S A CUBAN THING in the stretch, then came again under pressure to prevail. DISTINCT bumped between rivals on the backstretch, came out entering the turn causing PENNY'S HALO to clip heels, advanced into contention just off the rail leaving the turn, then rallied to be just up for the place. IT'S A CUBAN THING bumped with DISTINCT on the backstretch, chased the pace along the rail, slipped through to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then weakened. PACK'N THE SAND chased the pace three wide into the stretch and gave way. HI TIME'S LISA reserved racing along the rail, was steadied inside DISTINCT leaving the turn and failed to threaten. RUNNING DIABLO bumped with DISTINCT on the backstretch, chased the pace four wide to midstretch and tired. PENNY'S HALO clipped DISTINCT'S heels entering the turn and was eased. Following a stewards inquiry and a claim of foul by the rider of PENNY'S HALO, DISTINCT was disqualified and placed seventh for interference to that rival entering the turn.
