REGAL COUNTESS outran VERY EARLY SCOTCH for the lead around the first turn, moved to the inside to make the pace, shook off challenges from VEGAS ALARM on the far turn and VERY EARLY SCOTCH in the stretch and prevailed in a determined effort. VERY EARLY SCOTCH eased back off the pace after being outrun for the lead, advanced three wide around the far turn, made a run to reach near even terms for command inside the eighth pole but wasn't good enough. MISS ANNIE BEA reserved early, advanced into contention off the rail on the far turn, then outfinished the others for the show while unable to stay with the top two. VEGAS ALARM rated off the pace, made a run at REGAL COUNTESS on the far turn, then tired in the drive. HOLINESS hesitated at the start, saved ground into the stretch and faded. FLAMES IN THE SAND chased the pace into the far turn and stopped.
