### Footnotes

MASTER TASSEL stalked the pace racing off the rail, moved to take over nearing the quarter pole, then edged away. ENGINERY unhurried while saving ground, eased out in the stretch and rallied to prove second best. NOTE TO HARRY set the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. SERAPI CAT allowed to settle, improved his position in the drive. GATO PASO stalked the pace three wide into the far turn, then tired. ALMURAAD (IRE) stalked the pace into the stretch and faltered. NATHAN RIDGE raced four wide and faded.
