Footnotes

CAUGHT ON CAMERA set the pace under pressure off the rail, then repulsed a bid from MOVE THAT BUS in the stretch and edged away. MOVE THAT BUS well placed after being bumped and steadied at the start, advanced four wide around the turn to reach contention, made a run at the winner in midstretch but was outgamed to the wire. DENNIS' WORLD unhurried racing off the rail, passed tired rivals for the show. ROYAL JOKESTER rated off the pace after bumping MOVE THAT BUS at the start, raced four wide around the turn and tired. STRAIGHTEN MY HALO pressed the pace three wide to past midway of the turn, then faltered. SAILING CLEAR showed speed along the inside to the turn and faded. LAUGH N TOTHEBANK was outrun. JACKS RISK showed little. POPULAR DEMAND broke a step slowly, was done early and eased in the stretch run.
