PALATINE HILL set the pace off the rail, drew off racing down the backstretch and into the far turn, then was ridden out to maintain his advantage to the wire. UNO AGAIN rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and closed to prove best of the others while unable to gain on the winner. RED HILLS reserved off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals for the show. HUGO LIGHT chased the winner off the rail into the far turn, then couldn't stay with that rival and tired in the drive. EIGHT RIDERS steadied from tight quarters soon after the start and was not a factor. LIVE ON THE EDGE off slowly, was never close. BESSELINK tracked the leaders three wide into the far turn, then faltered. TRITONK was through after a half mile. JACKWAGON chased the pace along the inside into the far turn, faded and was eased in the stretch run.
