PAMPERED PRINCESS set the pace along the inside, then drew clear when set down for the drive. TUSCANY LIGHT rated off the pace, angled three wide on the far turn and closed to prove second best. SIERRA LADY unhurried early, swung out for the drive and passed tired rivals to gain the show. REALLY ROYAL chased the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. GYPSY DOT prompted the pace outside PAMPERED PRINCESS to nearing the stretch and faltered. MARNESIA LIGHT was outrun.
