SIR OSO raced with the pace three wide, moved to take over midway of the far turn, then was fully extended to just last over CHARKO. The latter, stalked the pace along the inside, lacked room in behind the leaders leaving the far turn, angled out and rallied to just miss. DARBY'S PAL tracked the pace three wide into the stretch, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while gaining the show. LINKIN broke through the gate prior to the start, prompted the pace outside HONOR CORP, made a run to reach even terms for command on the far turn, then tired. UNTUTTABLE AFFAIR steadied from tight quarters at the start and failed to menace. KING CASH was not a factor. MANOLO MANOLO was outrun. RALEIGH EXPRESS raced four wide and faltered. HARDTOBEAT BOB showed little. HONOR CORP set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then faded.
