SILVER CLOUD chased the pace off the rail, rallied to take over at the eighth pole, then drew clear. RED JAG reserved racing along the inside, steadied entering the turn, continued to save ground into the stretch, angled out and closed to be up for the place while unable to gain on the winner. FREEWEST sprinted to a clear lead while angling over to the rail, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. TRIPSKI tracked the pace, dropped back racing around the turn and failed to menace thereafter. ASSET EXCHANGE rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and had no response when asked. TAG TEAM (ARG) allowed to settle, was no factor after being checked entering the turn. WINNINGISGOOD was outrun.
