Footnotes

BOMBINO stalked the pace off the rail, rallied to reach STEADFAST CAT in the stretch, then wore that rival down late to prevail. STEDFAST CAT set the pace along the rail, responded when challenged by BOMBINO in the stretch and continued on gamely while unable to hold that rival off late. MR. KNICKERBOCKER stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. BRIGHT CASTLE reserved off the pace, advanced to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. KINVARA steadied soon after the start, moved up around the first turn to stalk the pace four wide to the top of the stretch and tired. ANGEL'S ROCK checked from tight quarters along the inside in the early going and failed to menace. FIRST WON raced four wide and was not a factor. WHY PHIL was outrun. DARK RUMOR stalked the pace along the rail into the far turn, then faltered. FRANKLINPARK was through after a half mile.
