SAMOA off slowly, angled out at the top of the stretch, rallied to take over at the sixteenth pole and prevailed while under restraint to keep from lugging in late. CRYPTOCANDIE reserved early, came out to rally between rivals and was up for the place while being outfinished. WANDERING PINE prompted the pace, moved to take over entering the far turn, drew clear in midstretch, then weakened late. DECOMPRESSED unhurried early, failed to threaten while improved her position. WEEKEND LOVE chased the pace, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then tired. SILKY'S TRIXIE steadied in behind the leaders on the first turn, raced in striking position into the far turn and faltered. ISLAND MAIDEN showed speed along the rail to the far turn and faded. DIXIE SPECIAL was never close.
