DECAPOLIS steadied racing into the first turn, saved ground, came out to split rivals entering the stretch, took over approaching the eighth pole, then was all out to last over SILVER INVITATION. The latter, rated off the pace, angled outside the winner in early stretch and was gaining at the finish. DINNER PARDNER made the pace along the inside into the stretch, then weakened. BACKROOM BLUES unhurried early, advanced into contention four wide on the far turn but couldn't sustain her bid. SAM'S FARIT stalked the pace three wide, made a run at the lead on the far turn, then tired. BEAUTY IS showed nothing. OCEAN AIR prompted the pace into the far turn, stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
