**Footnotes**

COLLABORATE reserved off the pace, rallied along the inside to gain the lead just past the eighth pole, then drew clear. TOUGH LOOK broke a step slowly, rushed up to vie for the lead outside BLACK SILVER, was floated out by that rival at the top of the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on gamely for the place. BLACK SILVER vied for the lead off the rail, then drifted out at the top of the stretch and was no match for the winner while being edged for the place. JAY ARTHUR rated off the pace, raced five wide around the turn and failed to menace. POSITIVE ACTION unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. BIG SKY GUY allowed to settle after bumping with STAR VIDEO at the start, advanced to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. WISE BLITZ off a step slowly, was never a factor. STAR VIDEO bumped with BIG SKY GUY at the start, was chasing the pace when steadied in behind the leaders entering the turn, continued to chase those rivals four wide into the stretch and tired. REDWOOD MAN chased the leaders four wide around the turn and faltered. ARTICIFER saved ground and faded. HOWARD'S EDGE was outrun while racing four wide.
