FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. With no nomination fee and \$250 to enter. Weights: Three Year Olds 118, Older 123.

Non-winners of \$25,000 at a mile or over since 12/1/11 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$20,000 at a mile or over since 3/1/12, 4 lbs.

After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. This race will be limited to 12 Starters, with Also Eligibles (High Weights Preferred). One (1) Supplemental nomination of \$500 to enter and start. Closed Saturday, June 16, 2012 with 17 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

WHERE'S STERLING reserved off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn, rallied to catch OLIGARCH inside the eighth pole, then drew clear. OLIGARCH set the pace off the rail to inside the eighth pole, then couldn't match strides with the winner while continuing on with good courage to hold the place. NUMB LIPS stalked the pace three wide into the stretch but had no response when asked. LIBERTY CAP stalked the pace off the rail into the stretch and tired. IMPERIAL CZAR rated off the pace, saved ground and faltered. NAVY WINGS was outrun. WINGEDLIE well placed early, faded.
