### Footnotes

SATELLITE PHONE showed speed along the inside, edged clear in the stretch, then was under pressure to last over CUTIE KITTY. The latter, reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and rallied to just miss catching the winner. BRITTEN'S BEAUTY off slowly, chased the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner late. HURRICANE FRANCES pressed the pace outside SATELLITE PHONE into the stretch, then weakened. HOMEROOM ANGEL chased the pace along the rail, was steadied when unable to get through inside SATELLITE PHONE entering the turn, then steadied a couple of more times inside that rival on the turn and gave way. AMERICAN ASSET unhurried after breaking slowly, gained some ground without threatening. POLYNESIAN SUNSET failed to menace. BARN DANCER off slowly, trailed.
