### Footnotes

SANSANNAH stalked the pace along the inside, eased out and rallied to catch PEARLICIOUS at the sixteenth pole, then edged away. COFFEE RUN unhurried while saving ground into the stretch, angled out for racing room and rallied to be up for the place. PEARLICIOUS set the pace, responded when challenged by MISS MUFFIN on the backstretch, vied with that rival into the stretch, edged clear, then gave way in the final sixteenth. A LITTLE OFF stalked the pace into the stretch but didn't do enough late. ALL TACKED UP failed to menace after breaking awkwardly. MISS MUFFIN chased the pace, made a run to engage PEARLICIOUS on the backstretch, vied with that rival into the stretch, then tired. GO ANNA GO chased the pace three wide to the top of the stretch, then faltered. A GLASS OF WATER steadied in traffic on the first turn and was not a factor.
