COOPER'S CURRENT tracked the speed off the rail, collared CINNAMON BUNS turning for home, and drew off under a steady hand ride. MI D'OR stumbled after the start, stalked the pace off the rail, and closed to be just up for the place. CINNAMON BUNS made the pace off the rail to the quarter pole, angled to the inside for the drive, then gave way just missing the place. METEOR DREAM allowed to settle, saved ground, and was no factor. FLATBUSH FLYER steadied after the start avoiding MI D'OR, and flashed speed until the turn. SAME TUNE trailed, swinging wide for the drive.
