MUSEUM TOUR prompted the pace three wide, edged clear midway on the turn, drew off and was not menaced thereafter. CHON advanced leaving the turn and rallied mildly to outfinish PHILOURPOCKETS. The latter raced well placed, moved into the attending position in early stretch but could not offer a closing response while finishing evenly. REPRIZED HALO ducked in sharply leaving the gate, moved to contention along the inside down the backstretch, was shuffled back approaching the far turn and could not menace thereafter. HAL saved ground and outlasted the others. KRIS AND ME hesitated at the start to come away well behind the others and was outrun. DOUBLE DOWN BROWN bore well out on the final turn and was no factor. PEACE BUSTER contested the pace along the inside and was done before a half. FORT PYRAMID flashed early speed near the inside, was shuffled back when outrun into the far turn and tired.
