BINGO BANGO BONGO stalked the pace off the rail, made a run to gain the lead midway of the far turn, then drew clear through the stretch under steady urging. BARBARO'S REVENGE rated off the pace, made a run three wide to reach near even terms for command with BINGO BANGO BONGO midway of the far turn, tried that rival into the stretch but couldn't stay with that one while clearly second best. DREAMING FREE (VEN) reserved while saving ground, moved into contention around the far turn, swung out for the stretch run and couldn't keep pace with the top ones. UNIVERSAL SOUL set the pace along the inside into the far turn, then tired. MR. MONARCH stalked the pace into the far turn and faltered. ROAR OF THE SURGE was done early.
