**Footnotes**

IT'S EDDIE'S CALL quickly moved to the fore, sprinted to a long lead racing down the backstretch, made the pace off the rail into the stretch, then shortened stride late and lasted over SWEETNDANDY. The latter, rated off the pace after being bumped in the run to the first turn, advanced off the rail around the far turn, then responded to pressure in the drive and was gaining quickly on the winner at the finish. RHYTHM IN MAY unhurried after being bumped and checked at the start, passed tired rivals for the show. MY NICKY reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and had no late response. ROCKCASTLE failed to threaten after being outrun early. BALTIMORE SAINT was no factor while racing five wide. WILLIE'S WAY was checked after coming in to bump BAHAMA DRAMA soundly racing into the first turn, raced four wide and tired. COUNTY TRICK chased the winner along the inside into the far turn and faltered. HOMELAND EXPRESS chased the pace into the far turn, then faded. BAHAMA DRAMA bumped RHYTHM IN MAY at the start, was roughed up when knocked into SWEETNDANDY racing into the first turn and through early. There was a stewards inquiry into the incident racing into the first turn. No action was taken.
