REGINA TWAIN stalked the pace, engaged for command on the far turn, gained a narrow advantage inside the eighth pole then withstood Trip For A.J. while drifting out slightly to brush that rival nearing the wire. Following an objection by the rider of Trip For A.J., Regina Twain was disqualified from first and placed second. TRIP FOR A. J. saved ground advancing on the final turn, eased out for the drive, finished willingly outside the leaders and just missed while brushed by the winner nearing the wire. MISS DELITE set the pace, resisted Regina Twain through midstretch then succumbed grudgingly near the end. MUSICAL ROMANCE steadied sharply along the hedge when Shes Trippin North angled in on the opening bend, checked briefly near the quarter pole while saving ground around the second turn, eased out for the drive but lacked a final response. TRIPPI'S SAILOR raced forwardly while three wide and weakened late. ATLANTIC HURRICANE raced four wide and tired. LADY CHARLIE raced wide and was no factor. DANCING RAGE was never a factor. MISS ARISTOCRAT flashed brief speed and tired. SHES TRIPPIN NORTH angled in on the clubhouse turn to impede Musical Romance, saved ground and faltered.
