THE ISABELLA ANGEL allowed to settle after breaking slowly, advanced into contention around the turn, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up in time. DARE TO DOUBLE chased the pace, moved to take over on the turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't hold off the winner in the closing strides. DIVA DELITE chased the pace three wide into the stretch and weakened. COME SUNDAY off slowly, saved ground around the turn and failed to menace. OUR PLUM PUTTING showed speed along the inside into the turn and tired. RUBY ROUGE hit the gate at the start, chased the pace to midway of the turn, then faltered. MISS OLIVIA RAE checked in traffic on the backstretch, raced three wide around the turn and faded.
