GAARA chased the pace, rallied to catch CASS'S FAST BALL at the top of the stretch, then drew away. GALACTIC GLIDE reserved early, raced off the rail and closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. VARITEK rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn and closed to be up for the show. ASISA'S ASSAULT reserved off the pace, passed tired rivals. DEVILISH MECKE moved up to track the leaders three wide around the turn, then tired. CASS'S FAST BALL sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to the top of the stretch, then faltered. JUMBO JUMBO was not a factor. LEADER WHIP was outrun. DOCTOR GARRETT chased the pace along the rail to the quarter pole, then faded.
