HEAVENLY MISS reserved along the inside, checked and came out over the heels of FORMAL MISS on the turn, angled to the outside in early stretch and rallied strongly to be up late. CRIMSON AND ROSES rated off the pace, rallied four wide around the turn, moved to take over in early stretch and opened a clear lead but couldn't hold off the winner late while clearly second best. FORMAL MISS chased the leaders off the rail, angled out for the drive and gained the show while no threat to the top ones. PASTA FAZOOOL outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. MEAMA failed to menace. FOREST NATIVE chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. RUNNING DEBATE was no factor while racing three wide. ELECTRICAL CARLITA showed speed off the rail into the stretch and faltered. SHELBY'S ANGEL showed brief speed along the inside and faded.
