LIZARD LICK set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then drew clear under pressure. WORTHY YOU stalked the pace, made a run at the leader on the far turn but couldn't stay with that rival in the drive while continuing on with good courage for the place. WEEKEND IN DEVON eased back off the leaders in the early going, moved into contention three wide on the far turn but couldn't gain late. LOVE ONE ANOTHER reserved in striking position off the pace, angled out for the drive and lacked a late response. BOM LUNA (ARG) tracked the pace, made a run to get inside LIZARD LICK racing down the backstretch, then was checked when she hit the rail nearing the far turn and tired. LUCKY ATTEMPT was not a factor. MARIA'S SUNSHINE trailed.
