STEEL HAMMER chased the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead inside the eighth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. ROLFSIE sprinted to a clear lead racing off the rail, responded when headed by STEEL HAMMER in the stretch and continued on gamely while just being edged to the wire. CALM EXPRESSIONS unhurried after breaking to the outside, angled out in early stretch knocking RULE SIXTY TWO into STRONG FIRE, then finished willingly for the show. STRONG FIRE outrun early, raced four wide around the turn, swung out even wider for the stretch run while rallying into contention, then was bumped by RULE SIXTY TWO in early stretch and didn't do enough late. U'RE GROUNDED tracked the pace along the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command in the stretch, then gave way. RULE SIXTY TWO rated off the pace after breaking slowly, raced three wide around the turn while advancing into contention, then was steadied when knocked into STRONG FIRE in early stretch and tired. FIRST KREWE trailed after breaking slow and being steadied behind CALM EXPRESSIONS at the start. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND CLAIMS OF FOUL BY THE TRAINERS OF STRONG FIRE AND RULE SIXTY TWO, CALM EXPRESSIONS WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SIXTH FOR INTERFERENCE TO THOSE RIVALS IN THE STRETCH.
