GOTTCHA CHU CHU rated off the pace, raced three wide around the turn, then rallied under pressure to be up in the final strides. RHYTHM OF MY SOUL reserved racing off the rail, eased out for the stretch run and rallied for the place while being outfinished by the winner. GREAT CHANCE vied for the lead along the rail, opened a clear lead in the stretch while coming off the inside, then gave way late and finished on even terms with GLASS BOTTLE. The latter, unhurried early, raced along the rail throughout and closed well to dead heat for the show. ANCHORWOMAN failed to menace. ELLERSLIE PARK vied for the lead outside GREAT CHANCE to midway of the turn, then faltered. ALL AMERICAN STAR was outrun while racing three wide.
