THE PIA ANGEL vied for the lead between horses into the turn, then drew off in the stretch and remained clear to wire under pressure. SKIPTOIT unhurried after bobbling at the start, rallied for the place while no threat to the winner. LIL MISS G was vying for the lead when she bumped twice with SHE'S GOT BLING and eased back nearing the end of the backstretch, remained in contention to the top of the stretch, then gave way. MINDY MICHELLE stalked the leaders four wide around the turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones. BRYCE'S GIRL was no factor while racing three wide. SHE'S GOT BLING vied for the lead along the inside, bumped a couple of times with LIL MISS G racing into the turn, then couldn't stay with the winner and faltered in the drive. DON'T LIKE TO FLY vied for the lead three wide into the turn, then couldn't match strides with the winner and faded.
