DELOSVIENTOS well handled while making the pace off the rail into the stretch, drew off while being kept to pressure. KRISTALI rated off the pace, raced three wide on the final turn and closed to prove best of the others while no match for the winner. JOEY BLUEEYES reserved off the pace after being steadied in the early going, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. BUCHAREST tracked the pace into the final turn and tired. FAMOUS FROLIC allowed to settle, advanced along the inside to reach the attending position on the final turn, then faltered. WEEDLE tracked the pace for six furlongs, then faded and was eased in the final eighth. SYNONYM was done early and eased in the stretch run. FOREIGN RUCKUS trailed and was eased leaving the final turn.
