Footnotes

MAGIC MECKE reserved after breaking slowly, stalked the pace, eased outside the leaders leaving the far turn, rallied to catch BLACK SCORPION nearing the sixteenth pole, then edged away. STARSHIP VALOR stalked the pace along the inside, angled out for room in the stretch and closed to be up for the place while being outfinished by the winner. BLACK SCORPION off slowly, stalked the pace, moved up outside STACY ON THE WIRE to gain the lead racing into the far turn, made the pace to nearing the sixteenth pole, then weakened. STACY ON THE WIRE set the pace along the rail, responded when BLACK SCORPION gained the advantage, stayed with that rival to the eighth pole, then gave way. STAR PLAYER up close early, dropped back when caught in tight soon after entering the first turn, raced in contention three wide around the far turn, then faltered. DECAF AGAIN trailed.
