BALTIMORE SAINT unhurried early, saved ground while advancing around the far turn, angled to the outside in the stretch, then rallied to be just up at the wire. CARLY'S REAL DEAL stalked the pace along the inside, angled outside the leaders leaving the far turn, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner at the wire. HOPEFULLY LUCKY set the pace along the rail to nearing the top of the stretch, then weakened. PICO BOLIVAR chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, made the pace to nearing the eighth pole, then gave way. CLAWER saved ground and failed to menace. DONT MESWIT GOLDIE stalked the pace to midway of the far turn, then tired. BLACK ANTILOPE was not a factor. EL UNO stalked the pace four wide into the far turn and faltered. RATTLESNAKE RED chased the pace three wide to midway of the turn, then faded.
