ADVANTAGE chased the pace three wide, moved to reach even terms for command approaching the quarter pole, was outmoved by YAMIPA in midstretch, then responded to pressure to wear that rival down late. YAMIPA chased the pace, gained a slim lead midway of the turn, edged away in midstretch, then just failed to last. VAGUE MEMORY rated off the pace, raced four wide on the turn and was gaining slowly at the finish. LAS MOCHES (MEX) failed to menace. LUCKY MOMENT showed little. GOLDEN SUMMER showed speed along the rail to midway of the turn, then faded.
