FABULOUS FRONTIER stalked the pace, eased outside the leaders on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead at the top of the stretch, then drew clear under pressure. I'M DANCING TOO reserved racing along the inside, rallied around the far turn to reach the attending position in the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. QUEEN'S KNIGHT rated off the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then tired. PRINCE HAZEEM outrun early, saved ground and improved his position without threatening. BACKSTAGE LOUNGE raced four wide and failed to menace. HOWARD'S EDGE set the pace under pressure along the inside to the top of the stretch, then faltered. MASTER JAY pressed the pace outside HOWARD'S EDGE to the top of the stretch, then faded. NONDISCLOSURE was through early.
