ANNIE ROE saved ground, steadied along behind the leaders leaving the backstretch and into the stretch, angled to the rail for clearance nearing midstretch, overtook the leader inside the eighth pole and drew off. FOR TERINA angled four wide into the stretch and finished willingly to be second best. JARDENIA prompted the pace from the outset, gained a short advantage into the stretch, held the lead to the sixteenth pole and tired. SILVER CHEST raced forwardly, rallied three wide around the second turn but could not sustain her bid. MI D' RULER saved ground setting the pace, remained prominent to the eighth pole and tired. SWEET ENTICEMENT was outrun.
