Footnotes

CONQUEROR JAK lagged for nearly six furlongs, angled wide while rallying into the stretch then finished strong down the middle of the track to be along in time. ROYAL TAPIT raced well placed while saving ground, eased three wide to commence his bid approaching the stretch, overtook the tiring leader between calls at midstretch but could not withstand the winner while failing to change leads at the end. JAKE CONRAD S set the pace while saving ground and held well to the end. THE PARTY'S OVER raced well placed outside early, made a run at the leader into the stretch, could not sustain the bid and weakened near the end. V I MONGOOSE took up briefly between horses into the first turn, saved ground to the stretch, eased out and passed tired ones. EL COBRE raced well placed outside rivals to the quarter pole and tired. ALISA'S ENGINEER broke a step slow, was hung five wide on the opening bend, remained wide throughout and never menaced. FALSE ECONOMY saved ground and was never a serious factor. HARD TWO IMAGINE eased off behind horses entering the backstretch and was outrun. PRINCE HAZEEM quickly dropped far back and was always outrun. BEHIND THE PEW had brief speed, stopped badly and was eased to the wire.
