MIRACLE RUNNER chased C D PLAYER into the stretch, then wore that rival down late to prevail. C D PLAYER showed speed along the rail, edged clear in midstretch, then gave way late. LOVE IN YOUR EYES chased the leaders three wide into the stretch, then didn't do enough late. PRINCESS SHEILA failed to menace. SAILING WIND chased the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. J'S JULE off slowly, was not a factor. GINNY'S QUEEN broke poorly, saved ground around the turn and faltered. ONE WAY WONDER trailed after being steadied from close quarters at the start and was eased in the final eighth.
