TRUST THE DEPUTY rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch AFLEET TEXAN at the sixteenth pole, then was fully extended to prevail. AFLEET TEXAN vied for the lead outside GULF RUCKUS, edged away from that rival in the stretch but couldn't resist the winner late. SCORBIT unhurried while saving ground, lacked room into the stretch, angled out and closed to gain the show. QUIET EMARATI well placed into the stretch, weakened. GULF RUCKUS vied for the lead along the rail into the far turn, then gave way. MZ'S DON ZULON moved up leaving the first turn to vie for the lead three wide into the far turn, then tired. NINEINTHENINE showed nothing. PRESSURE was through after a half mile.
