SPLASH OF SILVER stalked the leaders three wide, moved swiftly to command leaving the backstretch, settled into the stretch with a long lead and was kept under urging to maintain her advantage to the end. BLAKE'SLUCKYPENNY lagged early, saved ground into the stretch and was easily second best. NORMA CLAIRE outlasted the others. DREAMALITLEDREAM came three wide into the stretch and had no rally. EMMA'S FIRST TOUR forced the pace while saving ground, could not stay with the winner into the turn and steadily faded. PEACEPHILLY set the pace slightly removed from the inside, offered little resistance when challenged after a half mile and faded steadily thereafter. SACRED CLASS broke slowest, was hung wide around the clubhouse turn and was never a factor.
