LUCKY AFTERNOON steadied along and clipped heels when lacking room trying to slip inside the leaders nearing the quarter pole, re-rallied from between horses once settling into the stretch then finished fast despite rider losing his stick inside the eighth pole to overtake the leader and win going away. MISS RICHENEKA stalked the leaders while racing three wide, drew well clear from outside in early stretch but could not withstand the winner. LEETA steadied back from inside the leaders on the opening bend, steadied again when lacking room behind horses approaching the stretch, swung three wide for clearance, loomed boldly in early stretch and hung. AMBITIOUS THIEF contested the pace along the inside and gave way down the stretch. AL'S ANGEL saved ground to no avail. CATTY PATTY forced the issue from the outset, gained a brief advantage between horses into the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. MINNIEISTHESTORM took up briefly at the break and was not a factor. RULETA raced wide and was being eased coming to the wire.
