Footnotes

A CENTURIAN was hard used contesting the pace inside Special Song from the outset then edged clear in the final sixteenth. TROUBLES COMIN raced four wide into the stretch and rallied mildly. SPECIAL SONG dueled lapped on the winner to midstretch and gradually weakened. HELLEN'S CHOICE broke a step slow, raced wide while within striking distance turning for home and lacked the necessary response. PURELY PRECIOUS saved ground, took up inside Classic Brook leaving the quarter pole and never threatened. KIDSTRONG FEVER dropped back to last along the inside early, fanned wide into the stretch and was outrun. CLASSIC BROOK was hustled early to race within close contention to the stretch and tired.
